
3 Prong Approach:

- IDS 3003: Transfer Connections & Success Course
- Coaching
- Mentoring

Goal: Provide the resources and supports Transfer Students need to graduate and be successful in their future endeavors, while further promoting leadership skills and professional development opportunities for experienced transfer students.



IDS 3003: Transfer Connections & Success



Provide the Information you NEED

- Logistics: Peer-Led, 0-1 Credit Hour, Small Discussion Style Course
- **Objective:** Get students acquainted with the University, make connections with peers, and provide tools to help them be successful.
- Format: Various lessons on tools and skills such as Time Management, Communicating Professionally, and Well-Being combined with outings to experience campus resources, and ample opportunity to build connections.



IDS 3003 Growth and Potential

- Over the past year, we have seen tremendous growth allowing us to hire more peer leaders, and a full-time program coordinator, and expand our offerings to serve more students.
- We hope to continue to expand our capacity next year and beyond to make IDS 3003 a mandatory course for all incoming Transfer Students.



Coaching *Reduces the "Noise"*

- 30-minute meetings, bi-weekly
- Safe, 1-on-1 space to meet with a TSS staff member to check-in regularly and discuss transition challenges, celebrate wins, resource orientation, navigate university processes and develop plans of action for change.
- Tackling Transfer Shock and Imposter Syndrome








- 6 Graduate Assistants (increase from 2 in 23-24)
- Coaches develop Microevents (events with less than 30 students) to engage students in a small group environment
- Solution Focused Approach
- Diversity of disciplines for coaches

Transfer Community Mentors Normalizing the Experience



- Connecting new transfer students with an experienced transfer student
- Intentional matching: Major, college, interests, goals
- Required to meet at least once a month for at least 30 minutes
- Navigate challenges and get connected to other spaces on campus
- Nearly 200 volunteer mentors! Who are matched with at most 3 mentees.
- Capacity only limited only by the number of volunteers and interested students.

Transfer Advocacy Network



- Over 150 academic advisors working to share our programs. Annual Transfer Success Clinic and Advisor Tour.
- Academic Center for Excellence, Innovation Hub, Libraries, Student Government, and more. Built a network of resources for our team and our students.
- Work with Orientation team to both enhance the Orientation experience for transfer student and promote THRIVE25.




Summary
